Year 11 Intervention Sessions will run from 17th -21st December. The dates and times of these are below

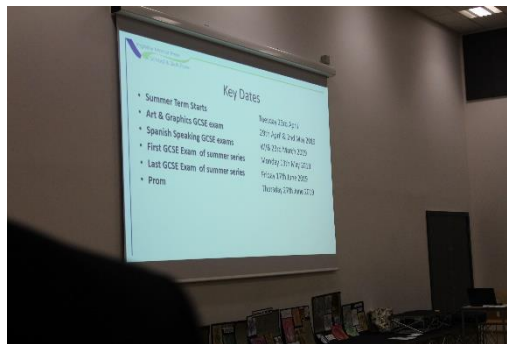
