

Each subject has a channel and within this, there is a files section where useful revision materials have been placed.


There are no intervention sessions *in school* this half term but the table below indicates recommended revision activities in each subject area and there are online sessions offered in Science and Geography. (*Students can join this by accepting the invite in the subject team*). This information will be shared with students in our Year 11 Mentor breakfast on Friday morning.

Subject	Recommended Materials/ Activities to support Revision (All in Easter Team)
History	See Paper 2 (American West and Elizabeth) and Paper 3 (Germany) Materials in the History Channel of Easter Team. Please note the videos on how to answer the exam questions, the signpost flashcards, the Germany Walking Talking Mock video from Easter intervention and the excellent resource for Elizabeth and Germany which is The History Teacher - YouTube . GCSE Pod is very useful for summary overviews too. The knowledge organisers for American West offer a good narrative overview of content and are invaluable.
Music	Exam revision is set in Teams and can be found in the Music channel.
English Language	Practise C1 and C2 reading papers from your red homework booklets. A bank of narrative titles and transactional tasks are on the Easter Revision Team. All students have their own narrative to practise and adapt to the questions online. We would strongly recommend practising planning/writing a range of transactional tasks including formal and informal letters, speeches, articles and reviews.

Spanish	<p>Exam revision is set in Teams and can be found in the Spanish channel.</p> <p>Reading You all have a paper copy of the Reading and Translation workbook to complete. An electronic copy can be found in Mrs Gonzalez/ Miss Aslett folders. Mark scheme is at the back of the workbook. Please look up any unknown vocabulary.</p> <p>Listening In the 'mock papers' folder, you will find past listening papers from 2018, 2019 and 2020 (LH – higher/ LF – foundation). Please use the mark scheme and the transcript to mark your work and look up any unknown vocabulary.</p> <p>Writing In the 'Writing resources' folder, there are writing resources for both foundation and higher. In the 'mock papers' folder, you will find past writing papers from 2018, 2019 and 2020 (WH – higher/ WF – foundation). Please hand in any completed questions to Mrs Gonzalez/ Miss Aslett to be marked.</p>
Chemistry	<p>Exam revision is set in Teams and can be found in the Science channel. Look specifically at the section on boosters and exam questions.</p> <p>On Tuesday 30th May between 9am and 10:30am, there is an ONLINE Chemistry drop in with Miss Baggott to ask any revision questions.</p>
Maths	<p>Exam revision is set in Teams and can be found in the Maths channel. Make sure you choose the correct tier of entry between higher and foundation.</p>
Geography	<p>Exam revision is set in Teams and can be found in the Geography channel. On Thursday 1st June, there is an ONLINE session between 10 and 12 am.</p>
